1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

- What happens between the time our death and the return of Christ?
- Theologians call this the <u>intermediate</u> <u>period</u>.

• Theory One: Soul Sleep.

For the living know that they will die, but the dead know nothing; they have no further reward, and even the memory of them is forgotten.

Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might, for in the grave, where you are going, there is neither working nor planning nor knowledge nor wisdom.
